Don't mail ballots for next week's election after tomorrow, drop them at registrar's office

To ensure that ballots reach election officials in time to be counted in Tuesday's election, voters should not return their ballots by mail after tomorrow (Aug. 21). The mail ballot election includes voters in the Idyllwild Fire Protection District and Rancho California Water District, and will be conducted completely by mail, so there will be no established polling places.

After tomorrow, voters are encouraged to return their ballots to the Registrar of Voters office at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside. Ballots can be deposited in the 24-hour drop box located outside the front entrance to the Registrar of Voters office.

Ballots must reach the registrar by 8 p.m. on Election Day to be counted. Ballots with postmarks before the deadline are not accepted and <u>cannot</u> be counted if they reach the registrar's office after the 8 p.m. deadline on Tuesday.
