## Vote-by-Mail ballots for April 8 election on the way starting Monday

Approximately 9,400 vote-by-mail ballots will be mailed to voters starting Monday (March 10) for the City of Rancho Mirage municipal mail ballot election on April 8. Ballots should arrive in mailboxes by the end of the week. Voted ballots must be received by the Registrar of Voters office by 8 p.m. on April 8 to be counted.

The April 8 election encompasses all of the City of Rancho Mirage and is not a countywide election. It is also an all mail ballot election, so there will be no established polling places. Call the Registrar's office at (951) 486-7200 if you have any questions about your eligibility to vote.

Vote-by-mail ballots can be returned through the postal service or deposited in vote-by-mail drop-off boxes located at the Rancho Mirage City Clerk's office or the Registrar of Voters office.

Early voting at the Registrar of Voters office begins Monday (March 10) and runs through April 8, Monday through Friday (excluding county holidays), from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
