## Voters encouraged to cast a ballot in the Rancho Mirage election

Tuesday (April 8) is Election Day for residents registered to vote in the City of Rancho Mirage mail-ballot municipal election. The election will be conducted completely by mail, so there will be no established polling places.

You may cast a ballot in the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside. Ballots may also be deposited in the vote-by-mail drop-off box located at the Rancho Mirage City Clerk's office.

All ballots must be in the possession of the Registrar of Voters by 8 p.m. on Election Day to be counted. Ballots that reach the registrar's office after the 8 p.m. deadline on Tuesday cannot be counted, even if they were postmarked before the deadline.

Interim Registrar of Voters Rebecca Spencer encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.
