Candidate filing opens

Anyone interested in running for office in the June 3 primary election may take out candidate filing papers beginning Monday (Feb. 10). Papers must be filed by 5 p.m. on March 7. If an incumbent fails to file, the deadline for that office is extended to 5 p.m. on March 12 for everyone except the incumbent.

The Registrar of Voters' staff is available to help complete the necessary paperwork and answer candidates' questions. Candidates unsure about the local district offices for which they are eligible, based on residency, should contact the Registrar of Voters for help. Candidates will receive informational handbooks when they obtain their papers.
