## Vote-by-mail ballots for June 6 Moreno Valley vacancy election on the way to voters starting Monday

Approximately 11,000 vote-by-mail ballots will be mailed to voters in the City of Moreno Valley next week for the June 6 special vacancy election for the City of Moreno Valley District 4 city council seat. Ballots will be sent starting Monday (5/8) and should arrive in mailboxes by the end of the week.

To be counted, completed ballots must be received at the Registrar of Voters office or any polling place within the City of Moreno Valley no later than the close of polls on Election Day, or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day. Vote-by-mail ballots can be returned through the postal service or deposited in the vote-by-mail drop-off box located at the city clerk's office.

A 24-hour drop box is available outside the main entrance of the registrar's office at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside. Vote-by-mail ballots also may be dropped off at any polling place within the City of Moreno Valley before 8 p.m. on Election Day.

Voters have until May 30 to request a vote-by-mail ballot by completing the request form on the back of their sample ballot, or by using the application form on the Registrar of Voters website at <u>www.voteinfo.net</u>. The request forms may be returned by mail or by facsimile to (951) 486-7272.

Early voting at the Registrar of Voters office begins Monday (5/8) and continues Monday through Friday, excluding county holidays, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The registrar's office will be open to voters on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote, please contact the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200.
