Please sign your own name (no one else can sign for you) on the signature line of the Unsigned Ballot Statement. If you are unable to sign your name, make a mark on the signature line. An 18 year old or older witness can observe you making your mark and must sign and date on the witness line.

- 1. In order to ensure that your vote by mail ballot will be counted, your statement should be completed and returned as soon as possible so that it can reach the elections official of the county in which your precinct is located no later than 5 p.m. on the eighth day after the election. (June 13, 2018)
- 2. You must sign your name on the line on the back of this letter (Voter's Signature).
- Place the statement into a mailing envelope addressed to your local elections official. Mail, deliver, or have delivered the completed statement to the elections official. Be sure there is sufficient postage if mailed and that the address of the elections official is correct. (An addressed, postage paid envelope is enclosed for your convenience)
- 4. If you do not wish to send the statement by mail or have it delivered, you may submit your completed statement by facsimile to (951) 486-7272, or email transmission to AnRoots@rivco.org, your local elections official, or submit your completed statement to a polling place within the county of Riverside or a ballot drop off box before the close of the polls on Election Day.
