

IMPORTANT DATES



First day you can vote. Registered voters who have requested to receive their ballot by mail will begin receiving their ballots on this day.



Registration Deadline. Check your registration status online or by calling our office.

* The registration deadline has been extended to the next business day because the 15th day prior to the election is a state holiday.



Early Voting available at the Registrar of Voters office from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (excluding holidays).



Last day to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot.

Vote at your polling place or mail in or drop off your Voteby-Mail ballot by today!

Polling places, the City Clerk's office and the Registrar of Voters office will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Mailed-in ballots must be postmarked by this date and received no later than March 5 to be counted.
