Ballots sent to all registered voters for the March 2, 2021 elections in the cities of Cathedral City and Eastvale

Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill 29 on Feb. 19 mandating that vote-by-mail ballots automatically be mailed to registered voters for all elections conducted in 2021. Based on the signing of the urgency legislation, the Riverside County Registrar of Voters has moved forward with mailing a ballot to all registered voters in the cities of Cathedral City and Eastvale.

Approximately 52,000 vote-by-mail ballots were previously mailed to voters prior to the adoption of the new legislation. An additional 10,500 ballots were mailed to voters in accordance with the new law.

All ballots, including vote-by-mail ballots, must be received at the Registrar of Voters Office or any polling place within Cathedral City or Eastvale no later than the close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.
