Dear Riverside County Voter,

All registered voters in Riverside County will be mailed a ballot in accordance with new legislation recently enacted by the State regarding the conduct of the California Gubernatorial Recall Election. Please note that this year the voting process is different. Each eligible registered voter for the September 14, 2021, California Gubernatorial Recall Election will receive a ballot by mail beginning Monday, August 16, 2021.

Voters can verify their voter registration status at [voterstatus.sos.ca.gov](https://voterstatus.sos.ca.gov) or register to vote at [registertovote.ca.gov](https://registertovote.ca.gov).

- Your Vote-By-Mail ballot may be returned at any of our 102 secure Ballot Drop-Off locations that will be available beginning August 16, 2021 or via USPS (no postage required).
- We are now operating nearly 145 Polling Places throughout Riverside County. You can vote in-person at your assigned polling place location from September 11 – September 14, 2021.
- You may track your ballot by registering at [WheresMyBallot.sos.ca.gov](https://WheresMyBallot.sos.ca.gov).
- A final list of the Ballot Drop-Off locations and Polling Places will be posted at [www.voteinfo.net](https://www.voteinfo.net) on August 16, 2021.

The Riverside County Registrar of Voters recommends that voters only use the in-person Polling Places if absolutely necessary, as the generalized use of in-person voting presents risks to public health and safety in light of the COVID-19 pandemic.
