Deadline to request vote-by-mail ballot for Jurupa incorporation vote is March 1

March 1 is the last day for voters to request a vote-by-mail ballot for the March 8 Jurupa Valley incorporation election. The incorporation vote and related items are the only issues on the ballot.

Requests must be received by the Registrar of Voters by 5 p.m. on March 1 for a ballot to be mailed to voters. To ensure requests are received before the deadline, voters should deliver requests in person to the registrar's office at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside or by fax to (951) 486-7272.

Request forms are located on the back of each sample ballot pamphlet and on the Registrar of Voters website at www.voteinfo.net. After the March 1 deadline, only inperson requests at the registrar's office can be honored. The Registrar of Voters office is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Voters may check the status of their vote-by-mail ballot on the registrar's website.

Processing of vote-by-mail ballots began Feb. 28 and will continue daily through Election Day. Registrar of Voters Kari Verjil expects that all of the vote-by-mail ballots returned before Election Day will be counted by the time the polls close and that results will be ready for release soon after. By law, the results from vote-by-mail ballots cannot be released until after the polls close.
