Tuesday is deadline to request vote-by-mail ballot for Nov. 8 general election

Tuesday (Nov. 1) is the last day for voters to request a vote-by-mail ballot for the Nov. 8 election. Requests must be received by the Registrar of Voters by 5 p.m. Tuesday for a ballot to be mailed. To ensure requests are received before the deadline, voters should deliver requests in person to the registrar's office at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside or by fax to (951) 486-7272.

Request forms are located on the back of each sample ballot pamphlet and on the Registrar of Voters website at <u>www.voteinfo.net</u>. After the deadline, only in-person requests made at the registrar's office can be honored. The Registrar of Voters office is open: Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday (Nov. 5) from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Voters may check the status of their vote-by-mail ballot on the registrar's website.

Processing of vote-by-mail ballots will begin on Friday (Oct. 28) and continue daily through Election Day. Registrar of Voters Kari Verjil expects that all vote-by-mail ballots returned before Election Day will be counted by the time the polls close and that results will be ready for release soon after. By law, the results from vote-by-mail ballots cannot be released until after the polls close.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The Nov. 8 election is not a countywide election, so some areas of the county are not included in the election. Call the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200 if you have any questions about your eligibility to vote.
