## Vote-by-Mail ballots on the way for the June 7, 2011 Election

Approximately 89,500 vote-by-mail ballots were mailed to voters today (May 9) for the Consolidated Special Election on June 7 and should be arriving in mailboxes by the end of the week. Voted ballots must be received by the Registrar of Voters office by 8 p.m. on June 7 to be counted in the upcoming election. The June 7, 2011 Election involves voters in the following jurisdictions:

- · City of Canyon Lake
- City of Menifee
- City of Riverside Wards 1, 3, 5 & 7
- City of Wildomar

Vote-by-Mail ballots can be returned through the postal service or deposited in vote-by-mail drop off boxes located at participating city clerk offices. The locations of drop-off boxes can be found on the Registrar's website at <a href="www.voteinfo.net">www.voteinfo.net</a>. A 24 hour drop box is also available outside the main entrance of the Registrar's office at 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside, CA 92507. Vote-by-Mail ballots may also be dropped off at any polling place within Riverside County before 8 p.m. on Election Day, June 7, 2011.

Voters have until May 31 to request a vote-by-mail ballot by completing the request form on the back of their sample ballot or by using the application form on the Registrar of Voters' website at <a href="https://www.voteinfo.net">www.voteinfo.net</a>. The forms may be returned by mail or facsimile to (951) 486-7272.

Early voting at the Registrar of Voters office at 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside, CA 92507 also began today (May 9) and is available through June 7.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** The City of Riverside Election is conducted completely by mail ballot, which means there are no established polling places.
