## Vote-by-mail ballots on the way for the May 1 election

Approximately 33,200 vote-by-mail ballots will be mailed to voters on Monday (April 2) for the special mail ballot election on May 1. Ballots should arrive in mailboxes by the end of the week. Voted ballots must be received by the Registrar of Voters office by 8 p.m. on May 1 to be counted in the upcoming election.

The special mail ballot election includes voters in the San Gorgonio Memorial Health Care District. The May 1 election will be conducted completely by mail ballot, which means there are no established polling places.

Vote-by-mail ballots can be deposited in a vote-by-mail drop-off box located at the district's main office at 600 N. Highland Springs Ave. in Banning. A 24-hour drop-box is also available outside the main entrance of the registrar's office at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside.

Early voting at the Registrar of Voters office begins on Monday (April 2) and continues through May 1.
