Drop-off locations established for March 12 Senate District 40 special primary election

Vote-by-mail drop-off locations for the Senate District 40 special primary election have been established at city clerk offices in Blythe, Cathedral City, Coachella and Indio. The locations will be available during regular business hours through March 11.

A 24-hour drop box also is available outside the main entrance of the Registrar of Voters office at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside. Vote-by-mail ballots also may be dropped off at any open polling place within Riverside County before 8 p.m. on Election Day.

The March 12 election encompasses all or portions of Blythe, Cathedral City, Coachella, East Blythe, Indio, Mecca and Thousand Palms and is not a countywide election.
