Registrar's office certifies results of Nov. 6 election

The Riverside County Registrar of Voters certified the results of the Nov. 6 election at 3:17 p.m. today (Monday) and forwarded the certified results to the Board of Supervisors. The final official election results and statement of vote are available on the Registrar of Voters website at www.voteinfo.net.

As of late this afternoon, the California Secretary of State website indicated seven of California's 58 counties had certified the Nov. 6 election results. It was not immediately clear from the website whether any counties had certified their results after the website was updated today at 2:58 p.m.

By law, a request for a recount must be filed with the Registrar of Voters office within five days after election results are certified. The deadline to request a recount is Dec. 3.
