## NOMINATION PERIOD FILING EXTENSION

If nomination documents for an incumbent are not delivered by 5:00 p.m. on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the primary election, any person other than the person who was the incumbent on the 88<sup>th</sup> day shall have until 5:00 p.m. on the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election to file nomination documents for the elective office. Below is the list of offices in Riverside County where the filing deadline is extended to Wednesday, March 14, 2012.

## PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD

The elections official shall make all nomination material available for public examination for a period of 10 calendar days immediately following the filing deadline. The public examination period for the above offices will be held from March 15 – March 24 due to the nomination period extension. The public examination period for all other offices will be held from March 10 – March 19.
