



**Certification of the Results of the Public Logic and Accuracy Testing
of the Voting System to be used in May 19, 2009, Consolidated
Special Statewide Election**

Commencing on April 13, 2009, and completing on April 21, 2009, Public Logic and Accuracy Testing of the Accessible Voting Units, Optical Scanners, WinEDS and WinETP system was performed in the office of the Registrar of Voters. During the test, all possible combinations of ballots were cast on all 487 Accessible Voting Units and 6 Optech 400C Optical scanners. These votes were then tallied and compared against the expected result previously made available to the public at the start of the testing.

The comparison showed that the equipment performed with 100% accuracy, as it has since Riverside County began using the Voting System in November 2000. Results are available for inspection at the Registrar of Voters Office.
