Dear Valley Health System Voter:

On December 15, 2009, Valley Health System is conducting a special election, as required by law, on whether to sell substantially all of its assets to Physicians for Healthy Hospitals, Inc. Information in this Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet will assist you in making an informed choice when marking your ballot. If you are not already registered to vote, please note that the last date to register for this Election is **November 30, 2009**.

There are many options to cast your ballot in this election.

- **Polling Place** Your polling place is listed on the back of this pamphlet. Polling places will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day, December 15.
- **Registrar of Voters Office** You may receive and cast your ballot at the Registrar of Voters Office located at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside, November 16, 2009 through the close of polls on Election Day. Early Voting will not be offered at the malls for this Election.
- Vote-by-Mail Request a vote-by-mail ballot and return it by mail at your convenience to reach the Registrar of Voters Office no later than the close of polls on Election Day. Postmarks are not accepted. Vote-by-mail ballots may also be turned in at any Valley Health System polling place on Election Day.

Completed ballots may be dropped off inside the Registrar of Voters Office daily during business hours or 24 hours a day in the drop box outside the main entrance. Voted ballots may also be deposited in a vote-by-mail drop off box at any Valley Health System polling place on Election Day. Ballots received after 8 p.m. on Election Day cannot be counted.

The ballot box is where we exercise our most cherished heritage and our proudest legacy - the right to vote. We look forward to your participation in this important Election.



ARGUMENT AGAINST MEASURE "P"

Measure "P" is nothing more than a sale of district assets to Physicians for Healthy Hospitals (PHH). The agreement to sell HVMC and MVMC to PHH was the result of an exclusive bidding process between PHH and Valley Health Systems' (VHS) Board of Directors. VHS refused to entertain offers from other prospective and well-qualified buyers, and then allowed PHH to pay for the assets with bankruptcy claims that have yet to be challenged.

The agreement does not ensure long term access to acute care services at HVMC and MVMC, but instead only requires that PHH maintain certain services for five (5) years and allows PHH to shut down services if they determine that such services are not economically viable. A "Yes" vote on Measure "P" may cause the community to lose access to care.

If Measure "P" is approved, PHH, Inc. will have a share of the healthcare delivery system in the San Jacinto Valley and the residents of the District will suffer in the form of increased costs.

Keep competition alive and vote "No" on Measure "P".

- Physicians for Healthy Hospitals is a group of 130 local doctors who are putting up their own money to keep our hospitals and emergency rooms open and to enhance medical care for local residents.
- In addition to ensuring continued access to emergency rooms and acute care services for all residents, including those insured through PPOs, HMOs, Medicare and MediCal, Physicians for Healthy Hospitals has also reached an association agreement with Catholic Healthcare West St. Bernardine Medical Center to offer <u>expanded</u> <u>services and access to many of the finest medical centers in the</u> region.
- There's a reason why local <u>physicians</u>, <u>nurses</u>, <u>paramedics</u>, <u>community and business leaders all support YES on Measure "P"</u> to preserve access to quality medical care. Vote YES on "P".





- Early Voting. You may vote at the Registrar of Voters office located at 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside, November 16 December 14, Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and Election Day, December 15, 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Curbside Voting on Election Day. If you are unable to enter the polling place due to a physical disability, you may request Curbside Voting at your assigned polling place. Upon arrival at the polling place, you will be allowed to vote in a location as near as possible to the entrance that is accessible to the physically disabled. If you require Curbside Voting, please call 1-877-663-9906 before going to your assigned polling place and/or when you arrive at the facility. An Election Officer will be contacted prior to your arrival to meet you at the curb.
