We have received your Vote-by-Mail ballot for the **June 4**, **2019 Mail Ballot Election**; however, it is incomplete. *Your Return Envelope was not signed*. **On the back of this sheet** is an Unsigned Ballot Statement form to fill out, sign, and return to us. A signature is required to process your Vote-by-Mail ballot (Elections Code 3011 (a) (2)). A postage paid envelope is also enclosed for returning this form.

Please sign your own name (no one else can sign for you) on the signature line of the Unsigned Ballot Statement. If you are unable to sign your name, make a mark on the signature line. <u>An 18 year old or older</u> witness can observe you making your mark and must sign and date on the witness line.

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING THE STATEMENT. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY CAUSE YOUR BALLOT NOT TO COUNT.

- 1. In order to ensure that your vote by mail ballot will be counted, your statement should be completed and returned as soon as possible so that it can reach the elections official of the county in which your precinct is located no later than 5 p.m. on the eighth day after the election. (June 12, 2019)
- 2. You must sign your name on the line on the back of this letter (Voter's Signature).
- 3. Place the statement into the enclosed addressed/postage paid envelope and mail, deliver or have delivered the completed statement to the Registrar of Voters, 2724 Gateway Dr., Riverside, CA 92507.
- 4. If you do not wish to send the statement by mail or have it delivered, you may submit your completed statement by facsimile to (951) 486-7272, or email transmission to rovweb@rivco.org, your local elections official. You can also drop off your statement at the Registrar of Voters' 24/7 drop box.

I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. I understand that my failure to sign this statement means that my vote by mail ballot will be invalidated.
