## **Voters encouraged to vote in tomorrow's Cathedral City special election**

Tuesday, August 27 is Election Day for residents registered to vote in the Cathedral City special vacancy mail ballot election. The election will be conducted completely by mail, so there will be no established polling places. The August 27 special vacancy mail ballot election is not a countywide election, so some areas of the county are not included in the election. If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote, please contact the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200.

You may cast a ballot in the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2724 Gateway Drive in Riverside.

All ballots must be in the possession of the Registrar of Voters Office no later than the close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.

The final election results will not be certified until September 12. A new law allows voters who forgot to sign their vote-by-mail return envelope to correct the missing signature within eight days after the election.

Registrar of Voters Rebecca Spencer encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.
