Registrar's office certifies results of Nov. 5 general election

The Riverside County Registrar of Voters office certified the results of the Nov. 5, 2019 consolidated general election today, Nov. 21, and forwarded the certified results to the Board of Supervisors. The final official election results and statement of votes are available on the Registrar of Voters website at www.voteinfo.net.

By law, a request for a recount must be filed with the Registrar of Voters office within five days after election results are certified. The deadline to request a recount is Nov. 26. The cost of a recount is paid for by the requestor. For information regarding the recount process, please call the Registrar of Voters office at (951) 486-7330.

The Registrar of Voters is given 28 days to certify election results. During the certification period a number of audits are performed to ensure the accuracy of the election results. During the certification audits for the Nov. 5 election, a small batch of ballots for Palm Springs District 2 City Council were found out of compliance during the initial run. According to the office's protocol and California election law, the batch was cancelled and re-processed. While the vote totals were slightly changed, the outcome of the election remains the same. The certified election results reflect the correct and accurate vote totals for all contests.
