Early voting available at Blindness Support Services in Riverside

The Riverside County Registrar of Voters and the City of Riverside has partnered with Blindness Support Services, Inc. to offer an early voting opportunity for voters with disabilities.

Early voting for the Nov. 5 consolidated general election will be available at Blindness Support Services on Friday, Oct. 25, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 3696 Beatty Drive in Riverside.

Early voting is also available at the Registrar of Voters office, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday, Oct. 26, and Nov. 2, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The registrar's office, 2720 Gateway Drive in Riverside, is open on Election Day from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Registered voters may attend any of the early voting sites to either drop off a vote-by-mail ballot or vote on an accessible voting unit.

Early voting provides access to voters who are unable to make it to the polls on Election Day and to those who would like their vote to be among the first counted on Election Night. Voters are encouraged to cast ballots as soon as possible so they can be included in the first Election Night results, which will be posted shortly after 8 p.m. on Nov. 5.

The Nov. 5 election is not a countywide election, so some areas of the county are not included in the election. If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote, please contact the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200.
