## **Voters encouraged to cast a ballot in tomorrow's general election**

Tuesday, Nov. 5, is Election Day for Riverside County residents registered to vote in the consolidated general election. Voters will be able to cast ballots at 53 polling places. To find your assigned polling place, please go to the Registrar of Voters' website at [www.voteinfo.net](http://www.voteinfo.net) or call (951) 486-7200. Polls are open from 7 a.m. through 8 p.m.

The Nov. 5 election is not a countywide election, so some areas of the county are not included in the election. If you have any questions about your eligibility to vote, please contact the registrar's office at (951) 486-7200.

You also may cast a ballot in the Registrar of Voters office on Election Day between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. The Registrar of Voters office is located at 2720 Gateway Drive in Riverside.

All ballots must be in the possession of the Registrar of Voters Office no later than the close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted.

The final election results will not be certified until Nov. 21. A new law allows voters who forgot to sign their vote-by-mail return envelope to correct the missing signature within eight days after the election.

Registrar of Voters Rebecca Spencer encourages every eligible voter to cast a ballot in the election.
