Dear City of Riverside Voter:

On June 4, 2019, the City of Riverside is conducting an election for the purpose of electing members of the City Council for Wards 1, 3, 5, and 7 for five-year terms. All ballots will be cast by mail-in. There will be no polling places.

Postage-paid envelopes are provided for mailed ballot return. Ballots may also be dropped off on any day at the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 7th Floor, 3900 Main Street or at the Registrar of Voters Office at 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside.

For further voter convenience, ballot drop-off locations within the Wards will be open on Monday, June 3 and Tuesday, June 4, 2019. Please refer to the enclosed materials for sites and hours of operation. To be counted, ballots must be received by the Registrar of Voters by close of polls on Election Day or be postmarked on or before June 4, 2019, and received by the Registrar of Voters by June 7, 2019. *All voters are encouraged to return ballots early.* 

May 20, 2019, is the last day to register to be eligible to vote in this election.

In person to:</li> <li>The Registrar of Voters office or the Riverside City Clerk's office during regular business hours and until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, or be postmarked on or before Election Day and received no later than three days after Election Day to be counted. For your convenience the Registrar's office has a locked drop box at its entry for ballot drop off 24 hours a day; or</li> <li>Designated ballot drop off locations listed below.</li> </ul>				
	c. You may verify that the Registrar of Voters has received your voted ballot by checking the return status online at <u>www.voteinfo.net</u> .				
•	<b>UNABLE TO RETURN YOUR BALLOT PERSONALLY?</b> State law allows you to authorize any individual to return your Vote-by-Mail ballot, as long as the authorized person does not receive any form of compensation based on the number of ballots returned. Have your designated representative complete the authorization statement on the enclosed return envelope.				
•	<ul> <li>SPOILED YOUR BALLOT? Place the ballot card in the enclosed return envelope, place a check mark in the spoiled box on the return envelope and return it to our office. A new ballot will be sent to you if there is sufficient time to do so. 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# **Conditional Voter Registration**

Did you forget to register? No problem! Did you know that during the period of 14 days prior to Election Day through and including Election Day, you can go to the office of the Riverside County Registrar of Voters to conditionally register to vote and vote? This process is called Conditional Voter Registration (CVR). Here's how it works:

- 1. Visit the Registrar of Voters office located at 2724 Gateway Drive, Riverside, CA 92507
- 2. Complete a voter registration card or register online at RegisterToVote.ca.gov
- 3. Vote your CVR provisional ballot. CVR ballots will only be issued at the office of the Registrar of Voters.

Once the county elections official processes the affidavit of registration, determines that you're eligible to register, and validates your information, the registration becomes permanent and your CVR provisional ballot will be counted.

# California Motor Voter

The California Motor Voter program is making registering to vote at the California Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) more convenient and secure. All eligible individuals completing driver license or ID card or change of address transactions at the DMV will be registered to vote with the California Secretary of State unless they "opt out" of automatic voter registration.

The California Motor Voter program applies to Californians who are 18 years or older and meet the following criteria:

- · A United States citizen and a resident of California.
- Not currently in state or federal prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony.
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court.

Note: Voter pre-registration is available for those 16 and 17 years of age. Their voter registration will become active automatically when they turn 18.

Before visiting a DMV field office, we recommend making an appointment. Visit *https://www.dmv.ca.gov/portal/dmv/ detail/portal/foa/welcome* to get started. You can also use DMV online services (*https://www.dmv.ca.gov/portal/dmv/ dmv/onlinesvcs*) to renew your driver license or ID card or change your address.

If you indicate you're eligible to vote, once you complete your driver license or state ID renewal form transaction online, by mail or in person at the DMV, your voter information is then transmitted securely and electronically to the California Secretary of State.

Please note that drivers with an AB 60 driver's license are not eligible to participate in the California Motor Voter program and are not eligible to vote.

#### Language Services

The County of Riverside is making voting easier in 2019! The Registrar of Voters office will have some translated sample ballots (but not all) that voters can use as a reference tool when voting.

If you wish to see one of these translated sample ballots before Election Day, you may request one. You can request one by calling (800) 773-VOTE (8683). Please be aware that only voters who live in particular areas can receive these translated sample ballots. Requests must be received no later than 7 days before an election.

#### Servicios de Idioma
